

# BROCKLEHURST MIDDLE SCHOOL

## SPORT ACADEMY REQUIREMENTS 2018 - 2019

Each academy has specific expectations and requirements as indicated below:

Aquatics Academy: **This is not a “learn to swim” program. Students are expected to already know how to swim.** It is important that students are passionate about swimming and have a desire to improve in all stroke techniques. They will also receive instruction in areas such as nutrition, fitness, sport psychology and other swimming related pursuits (eg. Water polo, scuba diving, lifeguard certification). Students should already be able to swim 100 meters nonstop or have Swim Kids 8 (Red Cross Swimming). If unsure, parents are invited to contact Mr. Brad Dalke (academy teacher) to discuss their son/daughter's suitability. Students are responsible for providing their own appropriate swimwear and accessories (goggles, nose plugs if needed). This academy takes place at the Canada Games Pool.

**Cost: \$350.** (which covers the cost of busing students to and from the Canada Games Pool for each class). **\$175 due at time of registration, \$175 can be spread out in the form of postdated cheques payable to Brocklehurst Middle School for months September 2018 - February 2019.**

Dance/Fitness Academy: **Dance Academy is able to accommodate students who have no previous dance experience as well as those that have had prior dance experience.** The academy will provide instruction in four types of dance (Ballet, Jazz, Contemporary and Hip Hop). The teacher will be supported by dance instructors from an outside agency. Students are responsible for providing their own appropriate footwear and clothing (ballet shoes, leggings, yoga pants, etc.) This academy is held in our drama/dance studio on site.

**Cost: \$225.** (which covers the cost of dance instructors to support the teacher in the delivery of specific dance instruction). **\$125 due at time of registration, \$100 can be spread out in the form of postdated cheques payable to Brocklehurst Middle School for months September 2018 - February 2019.**

Hockey Academy: Students in the Hockey Academy must be registered in Minor Hockey. **This is not a “learn to skate” program, and the focus is on individual skill development. As such, students must be participating in some level (House or Rep) of Minor Hockey.** Students are responsible for providing their own CSA approved equipment, and are also responsible for ensuring their equipment is brought to and from the Brocklehurst Arena (which is where the academy takes place).

**Cost: \$300.** (which covers the cost of additional coaches to support the teacher on the ice, as well as academy equipment such as pucks, shooter tutors, etc.). **\$150 due at time of registration, \$150 can be spread out in the form of postdated cheques payable to Brocklehurst Middle School for months September 2018 - February 2019.**

Soccer Academy: Students in the Soccer Academy **do not have to be registered in Minor Soccer**, although most of the academy students tend to be playing minor soccer (either House or Rep). Students are responsible for providing their own equipment (cleats, shin guards and appropriate training wear). This academy takes place on school fields during September, October, April, May and June. During winter months students are bused to and from the indoor Soccer Dome.

**Cost: \$475.** (which covers the cost of busing to and from the Soccer Dome late October until mid March, as well as the rental costs for the Soccer Dome). **\$250 due at time of registration, \$225 can be spread out in the form of postdated cheques payable to Brocklehurst Middle School for months September 2018 - February 2019.**

**Deposit due at time of registration. All Academy fees must be paid in full by February 2019 in order to enroll in the next year's Academy.**

**Parents/guardians and students are encouraged to contact the Principal and/or the academy instructor if you have any questions or concerns.** This registration form **must be accompanied** by the deposit amount listed for the academy and post-dated cheques for the balance of the fee (Cheques only please, payable to 'Brocklehurst Middle School') in order for a student to be considered for enrolment in the academy. **There is no financial assistance available at the school to cover the cost of student participation in sport academy classes. Students who have fees owing for an academy class from a previous year will not be considered for an academy until all outstanding fees are paid. The Sport Academy option is a privilege for students, and their behaviour, commitment and conduct is expected to be exemplary. Students who demonstrate poor conduct and/or lack of commitment may be removed from a Sport Academy following consultation with a parent/guardian.**
